On January 30, 2016, at the end of her third mandate, Mother María Luisa Gómez Tejeda has been re-elected abbess of Santa Ana d'Ávila (Diocese of Ávila, Spain) for an indefinite term.

2016 - The Venerable Seniors of the Order

On February 2, 2016, on the Feast of the Presentation of Jesus at the Temple, Sister Edwige of Blauvac is 103 years. Sister Edwige Talagrand was born on February 02, 1913 in S. Laurentles-Bouy (France). She entered the monastery on March 11, 1941 and made her solemn profession in 1946. She is the Venerable Senior of our Order with Father Bernard, of Scourmont, who will be 103 years in a few months... We already wish him a happy birthday!

Father Bernard de Give was born in Liege, Belgium, on May 8, 1913. He entered the Society of Jesus in 1931, and became a Cistercian at the abbey of Scourmont in 1972.

Mont-des-Cats

On 26 February 2016, Dom Ginepro Riva, Abbot of Tamié and Father Immediate of Mont-des-Cats, appointed Dom Marc-André Di Péa as Superior ad nutum of the Community. He began his service on that same day.

Dom Marc-André has been Superior of Maromby from 1999 to 2002 and from 2008 to 2014. At the time of his appointment, he was prior of the Community of Mont-des Cats.

On April 4, 2016, the Community of the Abbey of Koningsoord – Arnhem (The Netherlands) elected as abbess, for an indefinite term, Mother Julian Pieters.

<u>Message of Dom Stanislas of Mepkin</u> after the earthquake in Ecuador :

Dear All:

The earthquake in Ecuador yesterday (04/16/2016) was about 40 miles south of our Sisters in Esmeraldas, but they suffered very, very little damage, thank God. Here is a note I shared with the Brothers and the Juniors who are with us for their Seminar:

BROTHERS AND SISTERS

I just spoke with Sister Mónica at Esmeraldas. She assured me that they were well. After we talked she wrote:

Dear Fr. Stan,

Thanks for your message and phone call. The sisters have been very brave. After the quake we got together and we were all amazed at the fact that nobody started yelling or tried to run out or anything. We all just stayed calm and prayed. Fr. Richard was coming over with Mireya, for dinner. They had to take the hit on the sidewalk, they could not walk in any direction and they could hardly stand up! After two big movements in different directions, everything started rocking as if we were inside a boat in rough waters. We hope full power will be restored today. Fortunately I found an outlet to connect things, charge phones, etc... Maybe later on we will have no power at all. The town of Pedernales, I think, must be totally destroyed. We have good friends there (a priest and a sister). Please, help us pray for them. Thanks for everything. Peace, Mónica

Ampibanjinana

Mother Anne-Marie Gillot, Prioress of the Monastery of Ampibanjinana (diocese of Fianarantsoa - Madagascar) since 2004, having reached the age of retirement mentioned in ST 40.A of the Constitutions, presented her resignation to the Abbot General. With the consent of his Council, the Abbot General accepted the resignation which became effective on February 27, 2016.

On May 27, 2016, the Community of Ampibanjinana elected as Prioress for a six year term, **Sister Agnès Brugère**, a nun of the Abbey of Campeneac, foundress house of Ampibanjinana.

Mother Agnès was born in 1968 in Confolens (France). She entered Campeneac in 1992 and made her solemn profession in 1997.

Conyers

On May 29, 2016, Dom Francis Michael Stiteler having completing his second term as Abbot of Holy Spirit Abbey (Archidiocese of Atlanta, USA), the Community elected as Abbot for a six year term **Father Augustine Myslinski**.

Dom Augustine was born on July 17, 1958 in Chicago (USA), entered Holy Spirit Abbey on December 8, 1999, made his solemn profession on December 8, 2005 and was ordained a priest on April 30, 2011. At the time of his election he was the Prior of the Monastery.

On February 15, 2016, **Mother Annachiara Meli** completed her term as Prioress of the monastery of Mvanda (diocese of Kikwit, RDC).

Melleray

Because of their diminishing numbers, the monks of the Abbey of Melleray have partnered with the Chemin Neuf Community. Since September 17, 2015, twenty members of this community live in the abbey. A new phase began on June 19, 2016 with the celebration around the Bishop of Nantes with the gradual handover. It is not without pain for the monks but they have the consolation that the place continues to be a pole of prayer and a spiritual home for the Diocese.
