### **Viale Africa**

**TUESDAY, 10 JANUARY 2012**

**Father Edmond Rakotovao**, cellarer of the Generalate since 2006, has finished his service and will return to Maromby at the end of the month.

He is replaced by **Sr. Eleanor Campion** of Glencairn.

**Father William Dingwall**, having completed his term as secretary to the abbot general, will leave Rome in mid-January.

**Father Thomas Georgeon**, a monk of La Trappe and former abbot of Frattocchie, will take up the role at that time.

### **Liturgy**

**MONDAY, 16 JANUARY 2012**

#### **OCSO COLLECTS NOT INCLUDED IN THE ROMAN MISSAL**

In a ruling that also affects us, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments has concluded that nothing stands in the way of the continued use of the texts in the *Collection of Masses of the Blessed Virgin Mary*, which were translated before the introduction of the *Roman Missal, Third Edition*. They may continue to be used until such time as revised translations of these texts have been provided. However, the concluding formulae of the orations should be updated to reflect the newer text.

By analogy, the existing translation of OCSO Collects may continue to be used, but the concluding formulae of the orations should be updated to reflect the newer text.

**Dom John Bosco** was born in 1973 in Burungu (Dem. Rep. of Congo) and entered Mokoto in 1995. He made his solemn profession in 1998 and was ordained a priest in 2010. At the time of his appointment, he was Novice Master at Victoria.

### **Whitland**

**THURSDAY, 16 FEBRUARY 2012**

On the 14<sup>th</sup> of February 2012, at the end of her first term as Abbess, **Mother Christine Wood** was re-elected Abbess of O. L. of Holy Cross, Whitland (Wales - Great Britain) for an indefinite term.

On February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2012, at the end of her first mandate as prioress, **Mother Joëlle SCHMITZ** was reelected titular prioress of Jassonneix (Meymac) for a new six year term.

## **Gabriel Prize 2012**

MONDAY, 20 FEBRUARY 2012

The winner of **Gabriel Prize 2012** for Christian comics was announced on Feb17, 2012 in Brussels by the CRIABD jury (Religious Information and Analysis Centre for Comics). After lengthy deliberation, a sign of the very high quality of the entries, the prize was awarded to "A Life Given to God and to Mankind: The Monks of Tibhirine-Fès-Midelt," by Dominique BAR (illustrations) and Gaëtan EVRARD (story), published by éd. du Signe, Paris. This comic book traces the lives of nine French Cistercians in Algeria and the tragic death of seven of them in 1996.

## **Title of "Doctor" for Gertrude of Helfta**

SUNDAY, 26 FEBRUARY 2012

The steering committee for the project of having Gertrude of Helfta declared a doctor of the Church held its first meeting Feb. 15, 2012 at the Generalate of the Cistercian Order. The committee is made up of eight members:

- Dom Mauro-Giuseppe, abbot general O. Cist.
- Dom Philippe Dupont OSB, abbot of Solesmes
- Dom Olivier Quernadel OCSO, abbot of Citeaux
- M. Hildegarde Brem O.Cist., abbess of Mariastern-Gwiggen,
- M. Anne-Emmanuelle Deveche OCSO, abbess of Blauvac
- Sr. Augusta Tescari OCSO, nun of Vitorchiano, postulator OCSO
- Fr. Pierdomenico Volpi, O.Cist, monk of Casamari

(also invited were: Fr. Alfredo Simon OSB, monk of Valle de los Caidos, professor at Sant'Anselmo and reporter in the Congregation for the Causes of Saints).

The following topics were discussed:

- those persons who would be able to bear the burden of the cause, both morally and economically,
- support needed on various levels: episcopal conferences, religious orders, theologians, etc.,
- introduction of an abbess or a feminine member osb in the comitee
- the first steps to be taken: Sr. Augusta Tescari of Vitorchiano agreed to be the postulator for the cause and Fr. Pierdomenico Volpi of Casamari agreed to be vice-postulator,
- reasons for requesting that the title of Doctor be accorded to St. Gertrude: her renowned sanctity; her eminent teachings; her contribution to the development of theology based on her monastic and, in particular, liturgical experience; her keen sense of fraternal life in community; the female contribution to the life of the Church; the universal dimension of her mission; etc.

The members of the committee divided the various tasks to be accomplished before the next meeting, which was set for Sept. 30, 2012 at the Cistercian Generalate in Rome. One point was clear for everyone: it would be best if the cause for St. Gertrude being accorded the title "Doctor of the Church" be introduced by the family of all those who live according to the Rule of St. Benedict.

## **News of the Sisters in Syria (2)**

THURSDAY, 12 APRIL 2012

On March 27th 2012, Sr Adriana and Sr Annunciata left for Syria, while a sixth sister has chosen to wait at Valserena until the end of the hostilities. As flights were suspended, they went to Lebanon. With the help of the Sisters of Nazareth and of a Lebanese general they were able to cross the border and to rejoin the other sisters in the monastery. On Good Friday a young man of Azeir, which is in Damas, was killed by the rebels, plunging the whole village into sadness. On Easter Sunday the sisters sent a message to Valserena telling of their joy at being able to celebrate the Paschal Vigil, while Sunni soldiers kept guard for them! Let us continue to pray for peace in the world, and especially in Syria.

## **Ava**

THURSDAY, 12 APRIL 2012

Dom Brendan Freeman, Abbot of New Melleray (USA) and Father Immediate of Assumption Abbey (Ava), appointed **Father Alberic Maisog** Superior *ad nutum* of Assumption Abbey. ## **Regarding the Health of Dom Bernardo Olivera (1)**

THURSDAY, 10 MAY 2012

On Tuesday, 8 May, **Dom Bernardo Olivera** was at the Monastery of Quilvo in Chile to be the presenter at a course for the Formators in the REMILA Region. Dom Bernardo experienced the symptoms of an aneurysm. He was taken to the hospital in Rancagua and immediately transferred to a hospital in Santiago.

On Wednesday morning a procedure was performed to bypass the area of the aneurysm. The intervention was successful but because of blood in the area it could not be completely bypassed. It is hoped that the blood will dissipate naturally.

Dom Bernardo is being closely monitored since there is a concern if hydrocephalus develops which would demand an immediate operation.

It is reported that Dom Bernardo is in good spirits.

Let us continue to pray for him.

### **Regarding the Health of Dom Bernardo Olivera (2)**

SATURDAY, 12 MAY 2012

Father Eduardo of Azul has arrived at Miraflores for visiting **Dom Bernardo**.

At this time, Dom Bernardo is as well as possible and is now able to eat. He has to remain in Intense Care for 3 weeks to avoid a new hemorrhage, a new aneurism, prevent a risk of hydrocephaly or arterial spasm. Dom Bernardo appreciates your prayers.

### **Regarding the Health of Dom Bernardo Olivera (3)**

SATURDAY, 26 MAY 2012

A message of Dom Eduardo of Azul :

The eve of Pentecost brings us good news about the health of **Dom Bernardo**.

Until a couple of days ago he was kept in Intensive Care, making very good progress. The doctors found that his recuperation was very satisfactory, almost miraculous. If this continues, tomorrow possibly he will be moved to a regular room, without all the monitors. They will continue to observe him there for another week, and if everything goes well, will discharge him. After this, and before going back to Argentina, our plan is that he will spend a further week at Miraflores to ensure that he is recovered, and to be near the doctors who have attended him just in case there is need.

Our P. Santiago (infirmarian) will go there on Wednesday to wait for him. Bernardo is very grateful for the prayers of all, to which he attributes his improvement.

### **Warning**

TUESDAY, 29 MAY 2012

The Abbot of Val Notre-Dame, Dom André Barbeau, has asked us to alert the communities of the Order about strange requests coming from Canada:

Several monasteries of our Order in Spain, France and Switzerland have received a request from 4 or 5 young girls (Eileen, Maria, Olivia, Ursula and Michelle) from Toronto asking to join their community, with the patronage of a priest, Father Apollinaire Simantoto, said to belong first to the diocese of Toronto and then to that of Amos. The young girls or the priest send copies of baptism and confirmation certificates issued by the parish of St. Mary Mercy in Toronto. This parish does not exist, the certificates are false, and at this address there is a Roman Catholic parish of the Blessed Trinity which has existed for more than 40 years. The parish priest, Mgr Ambrose Sheehy, has confirmed that the whole business is a fraud, which will lead to a demand that the monasteries send money to cover the journey to Europe!
